

Central District MMEA Scholarship Awards 2009-2010

1. Eligibility Criteria

A. Applicant will graduate from said High School, having participated as a member of the 2009-10 Central District Band, Jazz Ensemble, Orchestra, or Chorus and have been RECOMMENDED for the 2009 All-State Concert Festival in his/her Senior year.

B. Applicant must be accepted in a four year college or university as a major in one of the following fields of concentration: Musicology, Music Theory/Composition, Music Therapy, Music Education, or Music Performance.

C. Applicant was an active member and supporter of his /her High School music organization where applicable and in good standing within their school community, and must also have been in good standing with the Central District MMEA. (The conductor of the High School performing group or the High School Principal must submit Confirmation statement.)

2. Application Procedure

A. Applicant must return completed application forms and personal statement to the conductor of the High School musical organization in which he/she performed, or the High School Principal.

B. Conductor or Principal must return:

1. Student's application form
2. Confirmation statement
3. Separate personal statement from student

C. Completed materials should be sent to the CDMMEA Scholarship Committee.
