Dr. Richard du Bois was appointed Associate Professor in the Department of Music at the University of Massachusetts in the Fall of 1965. Under his guidance the choral program at the University has increased from one to five vocal ensembles including the University Chorale, Chorus, Girl's Choir, Chamber Singers and Madrigal Singers. Each year the University Chorale, a highly selected a cappella choir, undertakes an extended concert tour.

Before coming to the University of Massachusetts, Dr. du Bois was director of choral music at Washington High School at Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Under his direction, the Washington Concert Choir achieved wide recognition in concert tours extending from Dallas, to New York City.

As a well known adjudicator and conductor of vocal festivals and clinics in the mid-west, Dr. du Bois is scheduled to conduct the Central District and the Western District Choral Festivals in Massachusetts this year.

Recently the Music Department appointed Dr. du Bois as Assistant Department Head.
