He received his Bachelor and Master of Music Degree from the New England Conservatory of Music and did further graduate work at the University of Illinois.

Mr. March has conducted the District Orchestras of Central, Western and Southeastern Massachusetts, also the Western Maine and Main All-State Orchestras.

His performing experiences have been with professional orchestras in the Mid-West and in New England as a violinist, and with chamber music groups as a violinist and violist.

Donald March has been Music Supervisor in Gorham and Laconia, New Hampshire, and has taught at the Harvard-Newton Summer School, University of New Hampshire Summer Youth Music School, The Newton Creative Arts Session, Simmons College. He also taught, as a Graduate Assistant, at the University of Illinois.

Mr. March has authored many articles for publication in the Music Educators Journal, Mass. Music News and other professional Journals.

A father of three talented children, Mr. March is an avid fisherman and canoeing enthusiast.

Cleveland L. Howard, conductor of this year's Central District Chorus was born in Greenport, Long Island, New York and received his early education in the public schools of that community.

Following High school graduation he enrolled at the Boston University College of Music from which he received his Bachelor of Music degree. Later he returned to Boston University and earned his Master of Music Education degree at the School of Fine and Applied Arts. He has pursued graduate studies at the Eastman School of Music, Rochester, New York, and been selected to attend the Institute for High School Music Teachers at Bennington College, a program of studies sponsored by the American Council of Learned Societies and the Ford Foundations.

Mr. Howard started his teaching career as Supervisor of Music in the schools of Wareham, Massachusetts. In 1955 he was appointed to the music staff of the Schenectady, New York Public Schools. Here he broadened his excellent grasp of the varied problems in music education by teaching vocal music on the elementary, the junior high and senior high level. All this valuable experience culminated in his appointment in 1960 as Head of the Music Department, Mont Pleasant High School.

Professionally, Mr. Howard has served as a vocal adjudicator for N.Y.S.M.A.; been the association's State Chairman of High School Choirs; and enjoyed the privilege of guest conducting such outstanding choral groups as the All State Choruses of New York, Vermont, Massachusetts, and the Tri-State Music Festival Chorus-Tanglewood; the Albany Catholic Diocesan Festival Chorus while being the active conductor of the Schenectady Light Opera Company and the All Souls Unitarian Church Choir.

Stanley D. Hettinger, Director of Bands at the University of New Hampshire, holds the rank of Assistant Professor and teaches woodwind instruments and conducting in the Music Department. Mr. Hettinger came to the University in September 1963, from Ohio where he was director of the Orrville High School Band and an instructor at Kent State University. The Orville High School Band under his direction received superior ratings in both District and State competitions for five consecutive years. They received the "Ohio Band of the Year" award from Kent State University in 1963 and were invited to perform in Mershon Auditorium at Ohio State University in 1964. Mr. Hettinger was active as a clinician, adjudicator and guest conductor in Ohio.

In July, 1966, Mr. Hettinger conducted bands at the University of Georgia High School Music Workshop. He has worked in the same capacity at Laurel Music Camp, Connecticut, in June 1967 and 1968. He has also conducted festival bands in New Hampshire, Maine, Massachusetts and Connecticut. In April, 1969, Mr. Hettinger will conduct the New Hampshire and Maine All-State Festival Bands. This past summer Mr. Hettinger was selected as one of ten College Band Directors throughout the nation to participate in a week-long Conducting Symposium at the University of Michigan.

Mr. Hettinger received a Bachelor of Music Degree from Ohio State University in 1955 and a Master of Music Education Degree from Vandercook College, Chicago, Illinois. He has done postgraduate work in Music Education at Youngstown University, Kent State University and the University of New Hampshire. He studied clarinet with Dr. Donald E. McGinnis at Ohio State University, Gino Cioffi of the Boston Symphony, and Gomer Pound at the University of Florida.

Mr. Hettinger is a member of the American School Band Directors Association, College Band Directors National Association, the National Association of College Wind and Percussion Instructors and Phi Beta Mu, National Bandmasters Honorary Fraternity.
