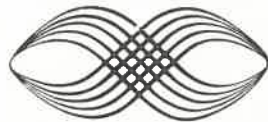

ORCHESTRA CONDUCTOR

Larry D. Allen has for the past seven years taught public school music from grades four through twelve. He has a Bachelor Degree from Baldwin and Wallace College and a Master's Degree from Hartt College of Music.

Mr. Allen is presently teaching at Talcott Junior High School in West Hartford, Connecticut where he has developed a "Total Music Program" for students which includes band, orchestra, choir, electronic music and guitar. He is director of instrumental music at Trinity College where he has developed a unique instrumental music program of small ensembles. He is English Hornist with the Hartford Symphony and Principal Oboist with the New Britain Symphony Orchestra. He has published two books based on his work at the junior high level: Beginning Electronic Music in the Classroom and Sound: The Raw Material of Music.

In addition, Mr Allen has written articles for state and national music journals regarding music programs for students at all levels of interest. In 1972, he spoke at the MENC National Convention in Atlanta, in 1973 at the Eastern Division Conference in Boston and in 1974 at the Convention in Anaheim, California.

ORCHESTRA MANAGER

Lorraine La Belle has taught strings in the Marlborough School System for the past three years. She received her Bachelor Degree in Music Education at the Hartt College of Music, where she was a member of the Hartt Symphonic Orchestra. She was an active participant of the orchestra in the All-New England Music Festival in 1968 and 1969, and the All-Eastern Music Festival. Miss LaBelle is also the director of the Marlborough All-City Orchestra.

CHORUS CONDUCTOR

Robert A. Lague is a graduate of New England Conservatory of Music with a B.M. in Music Education and an M.M. in Piano Performance. He is President of the Alumni Association of N.E.C. and Director of Music with the Arlington Friends of Drama and the First Congregationalist Church of Natick, Massachusetts. Presently, he is teaching at Muzzey Junior High School in Lexington where he has conducted the Muzzey Choir in All-State performances at Brockton and Chicopee and All-Eastern performances at Boston and Philadelphia and an ACDA convention in Boston. He has conducted Festival Choruses in New Hampshire and the Northeast District of Massachusetts.

Mr. Lague has performed with the N.E.C. Chorus in Europe at the Lucerne Festival and the Mazamet, France Bach Festival. He has also performed with the Boston Symphony Orchestra and is accompanist with the Northern Rhode Island Interfaith Choir. He is currently working on a Doctorate at the School of Fine Arts at Boston University.

CHORUS MANAGER

Jean-Paul E. Pagé is a graduate of Boston University and has studied at Assumption College and at Oberlin, Ohio where he was a member of the Teacher Performance Institute. He has directed groups in Worcester, Fitchburg, Boston, Maynard, South Carolina and Alabama. He is currently teaching at the Turkey Hill Middle School in Lunenburg, Massachusetts.

BAND CONDUCTOR

Walter Chesnut is an Associate Professor of Music at the University of Massachusetts. Besides teaching all the applied trumpet lessons he is director of the University Brass Choir and is a member of the faculty brass trio.

Having received both his Bachelor of Music and Master of Music Degrees from the University of Michigan, he became very active as a clinician, soloist and adjudicator in that area of the country. From 1959 to 1966 Mr. Chesnut was band and orchestra director in Colon and Sturgis, Michigan. His band and orchestra were consistent first division winners in district and state competitions.

Since arriving in the East Mr. Chesnut has conducted All Star Bands in Massachusetts and Vermont and has served as a clinician at New England All-State Conferences. He is very active as a trumpet clinician and conductor in the public schools of Massachusetts. He has toured Europe many times as a soloist and in 1975 was the guest artist with the Worcester Polytechnical Institute Glee Club playing piccolo trumpet throughout England. He has also been featured as a guest soloist with the Boston Pops Orchestra under Arthur Fiedler.

Professional Organizations include Kappa Kappa Psi, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia and Pi Kappa Lambda fraternities. He is presently State Chairman of the National Association of College Wind and Percussion Instructors. Professor Chesnut has been a member of the University of Massachusetts Music Department since 1967.

BAND MANAGER

Thomas Duca is a graduate of the University of Massachusetts where he studied trumpet with Walter Chesnut and received his Bachelor of Music Degree. He is presently teaching in the Spencer Public School System where he is the elementary and junior high school band director.

Mr. Duca has also done extensive nightclub work in the Boston-Worcester area. In addition to being Band Manager, he is a member of the American Federation of Musicians.
