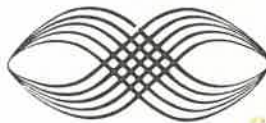

ORCHESTRA CONDUCTOR

WILLIAM PORDON is presently a member of the Music Education Faculty and Coordinator of Strings at the University of Lowell. Mr. Pordon has been active in string education and orchestra development since 1960. He is past president of the Massachusetts Chapter of the A.S.T.A.

Graduating from Chicago Conservatory of Music in 1951 with a B.M. and M.M. in violin, Mr. Pordon spent several years as a member of the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra before moving into music education. As a music educator Mr. Pordon has taught in the public schools of Atlanta and Augusta Georgia. After moving to New England he taught in Boston and Wayland. As a string clinician, adjudicator and guest conductor, he has appeared at state conventions and festivals in Massachusetts, Maine and New Hampshire.

ORCHESTRA MANAGER

Patrick C. Smith is a cum laude graduate of Hartt College of Music where he studied with Bernard Greenhouse, Raya Garbusova and participated in master classes with Mislav Rostropovich. He received his Master of Arts degree in Music Education at Columbia University and studied cello under David Wells at Manhattan School of Music.

Mr. Smith has belonged to various professional chamber music ensembles and several orchestras such as the Symphony of the New World in New York City and the Hartford Symphony Orchestra including solo appearances.

Presently Mr. Smith is principal cellist with the Worcester Orchestra and assistant principal with the Springfield Symphony Orchestra. He is a faculty member of the Worcester Community School for the Performing Arts, a co-conductor for the All-City String Orchestra and a string specialist with the Worcester Public Schools.

CHORUS CONDUCTOR

JOSEPH HUSZTI is currently Associate Professor of Music heading the choral activities and conducting studies at Boston University's School of Fine Arts. In the summers, Mr. Huszti directs Tanglewood's Young Vocalists Program designed to expand the musical horizons of outstanding high school singers.

Before coming to Boston University, he directed the choral and voice programs at the University of Delaware. In 1971 the Concert Choir of the University of Delaware toured nine European countries and competed in two international choral festivals. At the Koorfest in Holland, the choir placed second and in the International Musical Eisteddfod in Llangollen, Wales, the choir placed second in the Adult Mixed Choir Division.

In 1965, the Bakersfield College Choir, under Huszti's direction, won first prize in the International Musical Eisteddfod at Llangollen, Wales. This was the first American choir to win the Adult Mixed Choir Division and bring the coveted International Trophy to the United States. President Lyndon B. Johnson held a special White House Press Conference for the choir upon their return to the United States.

Mr. Huszti was awarded the Ecumenical Medal by Pope Paul VI in the summer of 1965. The choir was afforded a private audience by the Pope.

A native of Ohio, Mr. Huszti received his degrees from Northwestern University, Evanston, Illinois. Mr. Huszti is an accomplished violist and has conducted numerous orchestras and chamber music ensembles.

CHORUS MANAGER

Miss St. Onge received her Bachelor Degree in Music from Anna Maria College in Paxton, Massachusetts, and her Master Degree in Education from the College of Saint Rose in Albany, New York. She has done graduate work in voice at the New England Conservatory of Music in Boston and at Boston University.

For a number of years, Miss St. Onge was Assistant Professor of Music at Anna Maria College. She is presently teaching general music at Auburn Junior High School where she also directs the Junior High Chorus and a Special Chorus.

Miss St. Onge has been active in the Blackstone Valley School Music Association serving as Elementary Chorus Conductor and Junior Chorus Manager.
