John H. Hansen is Music Coordinator of the Quabbin Regional/Union #63 School Districts located in Barre, Massachusetts. Among his various duties as music coordinator, Mr. Hansen also teaches Music History, Music Theory, and conducts the Quabbin Regional High School Concert Band, Stage Band, and "Symphonic Winds". These musical ensembles have performed at Massachusetts All State Conferences (1973, 1974) and at numerous music colleges throughout New England (1973-1976). The Q.R.H.S. "Symphonic Winds" represented Massachusetts Bands at the 1977 All Eastern Conference in Washington, D.C.; and WON the 1977 Class A MICA State Band Festival. Mr. Hansen was Manager of the Massachusetts All State Band (1972); conducted the 1975 Vermont All State Band; was Manager of the All New England Festival Band (1974-1977); and is the founder and conductor of the 110 member Quabbin Community Band located in Barre, Massachusetts.

Mr. Hansen's educational background includes degree and post-graduate work at Hartt College of Music; the University of Connecticut; Boston University; and the University of Massachusetts. Professional memberships include: Life Membership in the Music Educators National Conference; Massachusetts Music Educators Association; Massachusetts Instrumental Conductors Association; National Band Association; National Association of Jazz Educators; and the American School Band Directors Association. Mr. Hansen is the founder and present Chairman of the Quabbin Valley Music Educators Association, and is the immediate Past Chairman of the Central District Massachusetts Music Educators Association.

**CONCERT CHAIRMAN**  
**ALTON L. BAGGETT**



Concert Chairman Alton L. Baggett is director of bands at Medway Junior-Senior High School. A graduate of Louisiana State University, his college summers were spent either at the National Music Camp, Interlochen, Michigan, or with the Ringling Brothers, Barnum and Bailey Circus Band. He continued his music studies at New England Conservatory of Music, a trumpet student of Mr. Roger Voisin.

Mr. Baggett is a member of the Central Massachusetts Symphony and the Music Masters of Framingham. He is also first trumpet in the Central New England Brass Quintet and founder and director of the Renaissance Brass Guild. His professional affiliations include membership in M.M.E.A., A.F.T., the Massachusetts Instrumental Conductors Association, the Boston Musicians Association, the Worcester Musicians Association, the National Band Association, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonic, an honorary music fraternity.

His bands have won several awards in marching and concert appearances, having been selected to march in the National Bicentennial Parade in Philadelphia, Pa. in 1976. He has been guest conductor with the Blackstone Valley School Music Association and was for several years active in that Association.

He operates his own private trumpet studio in Milford and is currently appearing throughout Massachusetts in concert with Steven Long, in preparation for a summer tour of Northern Europe, presenting programs of classical trumpet and organ music.

JOHN POELLEIN, *Conductor*

John Poellein is Professor of Music and Director of Choral Activities at The University of Connecticut. Under his direction the University Concert Choir and Chamber Singers have gained national and international recognition as two of the finest college choirs in New England. They have toured the Northeastern and Southern United States, Puerto Rico, and Eastern and Western Europe (in 1971 and 1975). In 1971 the Concert Choir spent two weeks in Vienna as one of seven invited American choirs participating in a Choral Symposium sponsored by the American Choral Directors Association and the Council on Intercultural Relations. John Poellein was one of five selected conductors at the 1969 Choral Symposium in Vienna.

Having received his doctorate from the University of Illinois, Dr. Poellein has conducted clinics and festival choirs in the midwest in addition to the New England area. He recently directed the Summer Music Session High School Chorus at The University of Illinois. He is an active member of Music Educators National Conference, the Connecticut Music Educators Association and is past state president of the American Choral Directors Association. His choirs have had highly successful appearances at both state and national meetings of these professional organizations.



JOHN P. BLACKWELL, *Chorus Manager*

Mr. John P. Blackwell is the Director of Music and Choral Director at Oakmont Regional High School - Ashburnham - Westminster, Mass. He is a graduate of Lowell University where he also received his Masters of Music with a major in choral music.

Mr. Blackwell was choral manager in 1967 and 1975 and has been Publicity Chairman for the Central District Massachusetts Music Educators Association.

Mr. Blackwell is a member of the Oakmont Teachers' Association, the Music Educators' National Conference and the American Choral Directors' Association. He has also been employed by the Allyn and Bacon Co. as an Educational Consultant.

Prior to coming to Lowell, Mr. Whiston completed his residency requirements for the PH D in Music Education at the University of Oklahoma where he also directed the University Concert Band.

Previous teaching experience includes nine years at Plymouth State College and the University of New Hampshire; eight years in the public schools of Ohio. Mr. Whiston has guest conducted and adjudicated in all of the New England states and in the mid-West, doing extensive work with marching bands throughout the Eastern United States, Oklahoma, Indiana, and Ohio.

In addition to his work at the University of Oklahoma, Mr. Whiston has done graduate work at the University of New Hampshire and the University of Akron, Ohio, where he completed a MS in school administration and Music supervision. His undergraduate degree was also from the University of Akron where he graduated with a MS degree in Music Education, Summa Cum Laude.

Mr. Whiston has been a member of the College Band Director's National Association, Kappa Delta P. National Education Honorary, New Hampshire Board of Directors for the State MENC and has served as an officer in the U.S. Army. He has also played trumpet professionally for the Akron Symphony Orchestra.
