JACK HELLER, Conductor

Jack Heller is Professor of Music at the University of Connecticut and Music Director and Conductor of the Manchester Civic Orchestra and Chorale. He received his undergraduate training at the Juilliard School of Music, master's degree from the University of Michigan, and Ph. D. from the University of Iowa.

Dr. Heller has had wide experience in the fields of performing, conducting, and teaching. He has been concertmaster of several symphony and opera orchestras, has toured with various chamber music groups, and has made numerous recital and solo appearances with orchestras across the country. He has been adjudicator and guest conductor for many high school district, state, and regional music competitions and festivals.

At the University of Connecticut, Dr. Heller is Coordinator of Music Education and Coordinator of Graduate Studies in Music. He has lectured in Europe and the United States on research in musical perception and learning, and is an active member of several key professional organizations. He is listed in Who's Who in the East as well as the International Who's Who in Music.

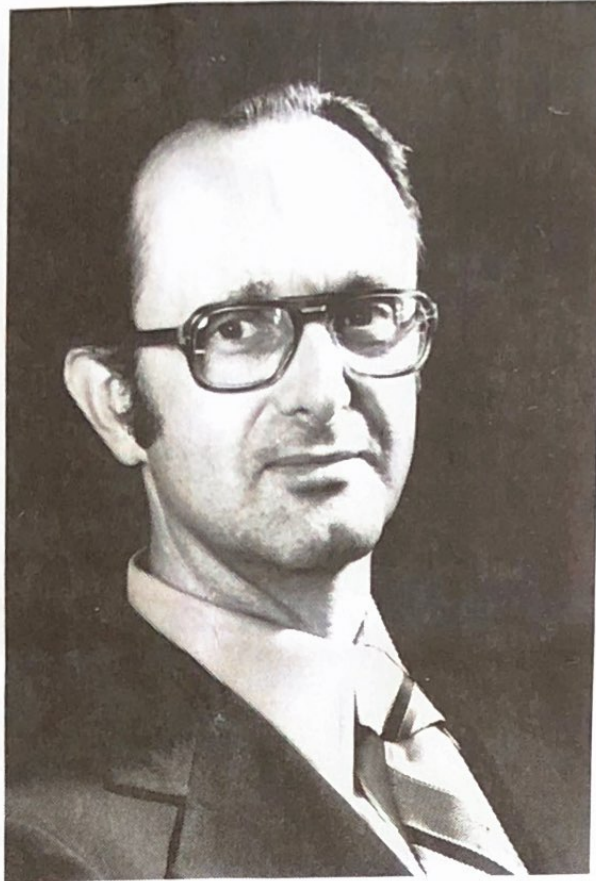

HENRY WING, JR., Conductor

Henry Wing, Jr. received both his B.M. and M.M. Degrees in Voice from Oberlin Conservatory. In 1966 he obtained his Ph.D. in Musicology from Boston University and is presently an Associate Professor of Music at the University of New Hampshire.

Dr. Wing has been Head of Voice and Music Theater Program at UNH since 1970. Formerly Assistant Professor of Voice and Choral Director at Elmira College and Colby/Sawyer College of New Hampshire, he has also had extensive recital and oratorio experience including two summers at Tanglewood. He taught voice at Boston University Summer School in 1965 and 1975. He has served as guest lecturer at the American Choral Director's Association Festival.

At UNH he is conductor of the UNH Chamber Chorus, Music Director of the Durham Summer Theater, and Choral Director of the Summer Youth Music School. Dr. Wing has recently been appointed Music Director of the Rockingham Choral Society. He is a member of the American Musicological Society, College Music Society, American Association of University Professors and American Choral Directors Association. He belongs to Pi Kappa Lambda, and Delta Psi Omega, honorary societies.

Thomas Ferrante teaches instrumental music and music theory at Waltham High School, where he conducts the Wind Ensemble, Jazz Ensemble, and small ensembles. His work with his high school jazz groups has had extraordinary success. Mr. Ferrante is also instructor of saxophone at the University of Lowell, and has conducted one of its two Jazz Ensembles. He has degrees in music from N.E. Conservatory of Music, and Boston Conservatory of Music. He has served MMEA many times as adjudicator, clinician, manager of the Northeast District Jazz Band and All-State Jazz Band Manager.

He has served the National Association of Jazz Educators as President of the Massachusetts Chapter and as Northeast Regional Coordinator. Mr. Ferrante has served as Guest Conductor for the Massachusetts Northeast District Junior Concert Band, the All-Cape Cod High School Symphonic Band, and the Rhode Island All-State Jazz Ensemble.

HARRY D. BLAKE, Conductor

Harry Blake received his B.A. and M.A. from New Mexico Highlands University. He has had extensive school music experience while he taught instrumental and vocal music in the public schools of Indiana, Michigan and Virginia.

In 1969 he became Assistant Director of Bands at New Mexico Highlands University, where he also taught brass and music theory. Mr. Blake later became Director of Bands at Fort Hunt High School in Alexandria, Virginia where his 85 piece symphonic band and 120 member marching band were consistently awarded first division ratings in all marching and contest preparations. The Fort Hunt Band was selected as the "grand champion" in the 1975, 1976, 1977, Apple Blossom Concert Band Competition. In 1976 in a competition sponsored by the National Bicentennial Commission, the Fort Hunt Band was awarded \$5,000 as the "best of bands" as it competed alongside 13 bands from the original colonies in all areas of concert, field show, and street marching.

Mr. Blake is currently Director of Bands at Frostburg State College in Frostburg, Maryland. His duties include writing and rehearsing a 112 member marching band, directing a 65 piece concert band and teaching various instrumental classes. Mr. Blake is a member of Phi Kappa Phi (National Honorary Academic Fraternity) and is listed in "Who's Who In American Colleges and Universities".
