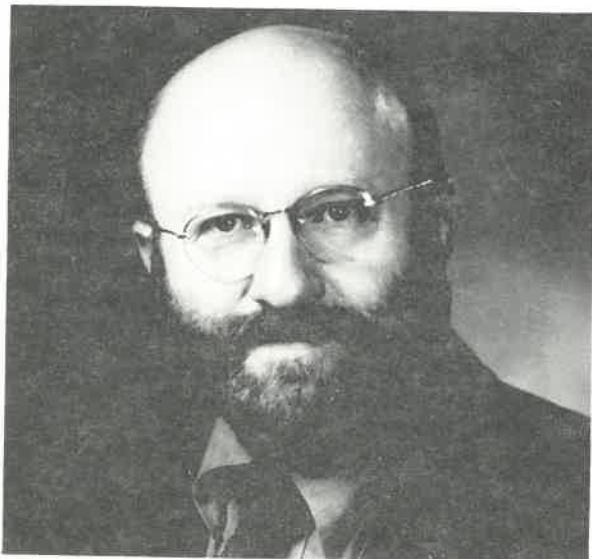

**WILLIAM A. SEYMOUR** is presently the Director of Performing Arts for the public schools of Brookline, Massachusetts, where he is developing a unique program in the allied arts of Music, Dance, and Drama in grades 1 through 12. Prior to his appointment in Brookline, he served for five years as the Associate Dean and Chairman of the Graduate Division at the Boston Conservatory of Music, with teaching responsibilities in Music Education and Choral Conducting, as well as conducting the widely acclaimed Conservatory Chorale. Formerly Director of Music for the public schools of Litchfield, Connecticut, and for eight years Choral Director at the high school in Brookline, he has also served as Director of Choral Activities at the University of Vermont Summer Music Session. As Founder and Conductor of the internationally known Concordia Youth Chorale, he has conducted more than 150 concerts in 14 countries of Europe, and has guest conducted festival choruses in Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Vermont, Rhode Island, Connecticut, and New York. Mr. Seymour was recently honored by the Massachusetts Music Educators Association as the recipient of the 1979 "Distinguished Service Award in Music Education."

He has studied conducting with Dr. Edward F. Gilday, Dr. James R. Houghton, and Robert Shaw. His organ teachers include Dr. Paul Giuliana, Richard Ellsasser, George Faxon, and Joan Lippincott.

He is currently Junior High Chairman having served the Central District as Secretary and member of various committees. He is also a member of the American Choral Directors Association, Organ Historical Society, Choristers Guild, and the American Guild of Organists. He has given choral workshops for the AGO and will be presenting a workshop at the regional convention of AGO in 1981. He is also in demand as a recitalist and has recorded for the MGM label and the Organ Historical Society.

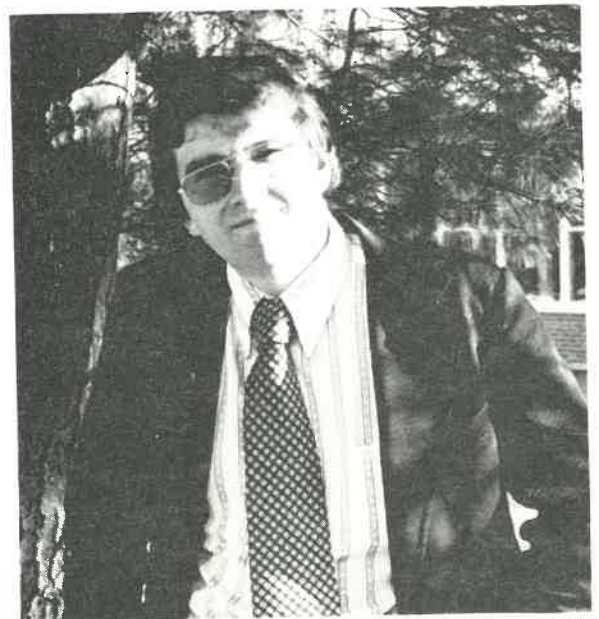

Peter L. Cokkinias is a faculty member at Tufts University in Medford, Massachusetts where he is responsible for the instruction of Music History, Orchestration, Music Theory, and Conducting as well as being director of the school's Chamber Music program and Band program. In addition, he performs extensively with major orchestras in New England as both a clarinetist and bass clarinetist. Those orchestras include the Boston Symphony Orchestra, Boston Pops Orchestra, Colonial and Schubert Theatre Orchestras, the Boston Opera Company, and others. Dr. Cokkinias has also been a guest lecturer at the University of Cincinnati in Ohio and Anna Maria College in Paxton, Massachusetts, as well as having some teaching experience in parochial schools.

Dr. Cokkinias first graduated from the Hartt College of Music in Hartford, Connecticut, where he received a Bachelor of Music and Music Education degree. He later went on to the Manhattan School of Music where he received a Master's degree and then to the Conservatory of Music of the University of Cincinnati, where he received his doctorate degree in music. Dr. Cokkinias was also a first clarinetist in the U.S.M.A. Band in West Point, New York. He was the visiting conductor of the Massachusetts Youth Wind Ensemble during the 1978-79 season and is presently the Assistant Conductor of the Civic Symphony Orchestra of Boston.

Thomas E. Reynolds is a graduate of the New England Conservatory of Music where he majored in both music education and trumpet, having studied with both Andre M. Come and Armando Ghitalla of the Boston Symphony Orchestra. As a student, he was manager of the internationally acclaimed Massachusetts Youth Wind Ensemble as well as being its trumpet section coach. He has formerly taught in the Quaboag Regional School District, Warren-West Brookfield, and in the Music Department of Newton North High School and Belmont Hill School. Mr. Reynolds has performed in several orchestras including the New England Conservatory Symphony Orchestra, the Brockton Symphony, the Concord Orchestra, and the Salem Philharmonic. He is also a member of the Bridgewater Antiphonal Brass Society.

Presently, Mr. Reynolds is the instrumental music director in the Algonquin Regional School District, Northborough-Southborough, Massachusetts and is Assistant Music Director at St. Joseph's, Wakefield, Mass. He is a member of MENC/MEEA, the New England Music Festival Association, and Pi Kappa Lambda.
