ORCHESTRA CONDUCTOR

Roger McClentic is a graduate of Boston University and has a master's degree from Boston Conservatory of Music. He has done additional graduate work at Berklee College of Music, University of Hartford, Massachusetts College of Art, and the Art Institute of Boston.

Mr. McClentic has been Supervisor of Music for the Winchester, New Hampshire School District, Band Director for Greenfield High School, and was, for fifteen years, Supervisor of Music and Dramatic Arts for the Ayer Schools. He has also served on the faculty of the Governor's School at the University of Rhode Island, and of Regis College.

Since 1980, Mr. McClentic has been Director of Fine Arts for the Hingham Public Schools where he directs the faculty of the art and music departments and teaches orchestra and music theory. He is also on the faculty of the South Shore Conservatory of Music.

Mr. McClentic has served as adjudicator and clinician for the Massachusetts Music Educators All State Conference and the Music Educators National Conference and is a frequent festival adjudicator, soloist, and conductor. He served as President of Save Music in Education and is presently a member of the Executive Board of the Massachusetts Music Educators Association.

ORCHESTRA MANAGER

Donald Thatcher is a graduate of Boston University where he received both Bachelors and Masters Degrees. He has been Director of Music for the Milford Public Schools for the past fifteen years and, previous to that, at Nimpuc Regional as Supervisor of Music for eight years.

Mr. Thatcher has been involved in MMEA Central District since 1960. He has been District Chairman, Treasurer, Concert Chairman, Band Manager, Chorus Manager, Host to festivals and concerts, and a member of the State Executive Board. He has also served as adjudicator at the district and state levels and was involved in the recent All-Eastern program in Boston.

CHORUS CONDUCTOR

Dr. Dwight Killam is presently Professor of Music at North Adams State College In Massachusetts where he has been on the faculty since 1973. He is well known in Massachusetts as an active member of the Massachusetts Music Educators Association and other professional affiliations. He has served MMEA in the following capacities: Chair of Western District 1963-65; Chairman of the Tanglewood Symposium Project; Vice President of MMEA Committee of Standards.

Dr. Killam is a graduate of Syracuse University where he received a Bachelor of Music Education Degree. He also earned the following Degrees from Boston University — Master of Music in 1957 and Doctor of Music Arts in 1972. Prior to his appointment at North Adams State he served as the Director of Music for the Hampden-Wilbraham Regional School District for fourteen years.

As a performer Dr. Killam has appeared as an organ recitalist in New York, Rhode Island, Maine and Massachusetts. As a clinician he has served at various events sponsored by the American Guild of Organists. As a festival conductor he has directed choirs in New York and Massachusetts. Dr. Killam's service to music and education have earned him the MMEA Distinguished Services Award, the Lowell Mason Award, and recognition in the International "Who's Who of Music and Musicians".

CHORUS MANAGER

Carol Archambault has taught vocal music in grades kindergarten through eighth in the Lancaster Public Schools for the past five years. She has previously served the Central District MMEA as the Assistant Manager of the Junior High Chorus in 1983. She has also been a conductor for the Wachusett Music Educators Association. Carol received her Bachelor's Degree in Music Education from the University of Lowell and is currently working towards a Master's of Education Degree in Creative Arts at Fitchburg State College.

BAND CONDUCTOR

Dr. Lee Chrisman is a well known and respected member of the Music Educators National Conference and the Massachusetts Music Educators Association. He is a Past President of the Eastern Divison of MENC and a recipient of the Distinguished Service Award of MMEA. He is a member of the Board for Young Audiences of Massachusetts, a member of the College Band Directors National Association and the American String Teachers Association. He has served as clinician, adjudicator, and conductor of innumerable District and All-State concerts throughout Massachusetts and the United States. He is the author of "A Musical Peformance Evaluation Schema".

Dr. Chrisman is a graduate of the University of Michigan where he received his Bachelor and Master's Degrees. He was granted a Doctorate Degree of Education from the University of Southern California. His teaching career began in the public schools of Ann Arbor, Michigan and Mason City, Iowa. He has taught at Pasadena City College and California State College at San Francisco. He is presently Chairman of the Music Education Department at Boston University where he is also Director of the Music Organizations.

Dr. Chrisman's service to music performance and music education during an illustrious career has been duly recognized both throughout New England and nationally.

BAND MANAGER

Thomas Kruczek has been an instrumental music instructor for the Southbridge Public Schools for the past fourteen years. He earned a Bachelor of Music Degree from Boston University and a Master of Arts Degree form Columbia University. His career in education includes: instrumental and general music instructor at North Junior High School in Brockton; assistant conductor of the Bridgewater State College Jazz Ensemble; Director of the Wellesley Town Band; and Director of the Pulaski Brass Band of Webster, Mass. As a performer Tom has been a member of the following musical organizations: the Hingham Civic Orchestra, the Brockton Symphony Orchestra, the South Shore Concert Band, and the Boston University Alumni Band. He has helped to organize and promote the South County and Dual-County music festivals and has served on the Quinebaug Valley Council for the Arts and Humanities.
