

ALEXANDER DASHNAW

Alexander Dashnaw is Professor of Music and Director of Choral Activities at the C. W. Post Campus of Long Island University. He served as Director of Choral Activities at the Hartt School of Music, University of Hartford and was conductor of the Brooklyn Philharmonia Chorus from 1980 -1985. In 1981, he formed a professionl chorus - The Manhattan Chorale and has presented concerts at, among others, the Kennedy Center, Carnegie Hall, and the Brooklyn Academy of Music. He has served as President of the Eastern Division of the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA) and has appeared as clinician for the New York State School Music Association (NYSSMA), the ACDA, and the American Guild of Organists (AGO). He has conducted concerts throughout western Europe, England, Wales, Mexico, Canada, and the U.S. Virgin Islands, as well as in the United States. He is often the guest conductor of area, honors, and all-state choruses and is the Artistic Director of many festivals, including the Jubilee Festival in Washington, D.C., the Manhattan, Chicago, and San Francisco Choral Festivals in the U.S. and the Strathclyde Festival in Glasgow, Scotland

JAZZ ENSEMBLE HERB POMEROY

Biography: Herb Pomeroy

Herb Pomeroy has become known as a "musician's musician", a leader in big band jazz, an improviser of uncommon stature, a legendary educator at the Berklee College of Music, and an artist of the highest caliber.

During his career, Herb has performed with Charlie Parker (Charlie Parker at Storyville) Duke Ellington, Lionel Hampton, Gerry Mulligan, Serge Chaloff, Benny Golson, Stan Kenton, Stan Getz, Zoot Sims, Coleman Hawkins, Roy Eldridge, and many others.


Mr. Pomeroy has also recorded with the Boston Pops, Charlie Parker, Serge Chaloff, and his own Herb Pomeroy Big Band.

He has been a professor at the Berklee College of Music for over thirty five years, and has instructed students such as Gary Burton, Alan Broadbent, Gary McFarland, Toshiko Akiyoshi, Mike Gibbs, and Arif Mardin.

He has also lectured at Harvard, Yale, Case Western, Michigan State, MIT, and other Universities.

In addition to his performing, teaching and edjudicating, Mr. Pomeroy is also an active composer. Among his compositions is "A Window of Mirrors" written for the Boston Ballet Company.

As a result of his accomplishments he was the first recipient of the Berklee College of Music's Alumni Association Award.

EDWIN C. DEGROAT

CENTRAL DISTRICT ORCHESTRA

Edwin C. DeGroat is presently conductor of the orchestras at Conard and Hall High Schools in West Hartford, Connecticut. He is also the founder and director of I Giovani Solisti (the young soloists) which is a twenty-one member ensemble of the most gifted and committed string players of both high schools. They have toured, by invitation, the British Isles on three occasions (1985, 1987, and 1989) and have performed with double bassist, Cary Karr (1984) flautist, Eugenia Zukerman (1986) and violinists, David Kim (1988) and Peter Winograd (1990).

He was the executive director of the Hartford Camerata Conservatory from 1985-1988 and had been in the administration since 1983.

Mr. DeGroat served as the educational program advisor of the Hartford Symphony from 1977-1983 where he designed and narrated all the young people's concerts at the Bushnell Memorial. He expanded audiences in excess of 24,000 annually.

He is presently the founder and executive director of the Connecticut Institute for Arts and Education which offers programs emphasizing aesthetic education where the arts are the central focus of activities. As a trumpet player, he has been an active performing musician in the Hartford area since 1961 and was also in demand while living in Washington, D.C. from 1975-1976. As a conductor, he has performed throughout the northeast and Canada.

A member of the Music Educators National Conference and the Connecticut Music Educator's Association, he has served on many state, regional, and national committees. He is presently the chairman of the 1990 All-State and All-New England Orchestras.

He is presently enrolled in a Ph.D program in Arts and Humanities at New York University.


