Orchestra

ANN DANIS is Professor of Music and the Director of Orchestral Activities at the University of Rhode Island. She is in demand as a performer on violin and viola, clinician, and as a guest conductor throughout the country. She founded the Ocean State Chamber Orchestra in 1991 and the Ocean State Youth Orchestra in 1999 and served as the Artistic Director and Conductor for both organizations. Ms. Danis has served as an assistant conductor for the Rhode Island Philharmonic and the conductor of the Philharmonic's Senior Youth Orchestra. Locally, she has also conducted the Festival Ballet of Providence Orchestra, Ocean State Lyric Opera, Claflin Hill Symphony, the Franklin School for the Performing Arts Orchestra, and many joint endeavors between her professional chamber orchestra and organizations such as Sine Nomine, Schola Cantorum of Boston, Brown University Chorus, South County Chamber Singers, among others. She has been a member of orchestras throughout the country as well as several professional chamber ensembles. In addition to her conducting and scholarly activities, Ann is the current Music Director and Conductor of the Fall River (MA) Symphony Orchestra, a community orchestra based in her hometown.

Ms. Danis graduated with High Honors from the New England Conservatory of Music where she earned undergraduate and graduate degrees in violin performance. Her principle teachers at NEC were George Zazofsky and Joseph Silverstein. She was a Graduate Assistant in early music and worked with such notables as Daniel Pinkham, Rudolph Kolisch, James Pappoutsakis, and Aldo Parisot. At NEC, she studied conducting with Richard Pittman and later with Andrew Massey. Between 1990 and 2009, Ms. Danis as led All-State and Festival Orchestras in Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island, Vermont, New Hampshire, Maine, North Carolina, Virginia, Washington, Georgia, and New York. Recognized by critics and audiences for her innovative and daring programming, Ms. Danis has demonstrated a firm commitment to the presentation of new works and exposing audiences to modern repertoire in a casual and informative setting.

Jazz Ensemble

Guitarist/Composer/Educator, John Baboian has been on the faculty at Berklee College of Music in Boston since 1980. Before beginning his teaching career at Berklee he received a Bachelors Degree in Music Education from Berklee and later a Masters Degree in Jazz Studies from New England Conservatory. Although best known for his work in the jazz & swing idioms, John has performed in the classical, blues, rock, R&B, Latin and World music genres. His performances range from concerts and clubs to recordings, radio and television throughout the United States and Canada. Abroad, he has performed and hosted clinics in Japan, Central & South Americas, Europe, South Africa, and the former

Soviet Union including his ancestral home, Armenia. His compositions and arrangements have been heard on television shows including "Walker, Texas Ranger", UPN's "Seven Days", ABC's "All My Children", HBO's "The Soprano's", and others. He has accompanied headliners Frankie Avalon, Sergio Franchi, Connie Francis, Tom Jones, Al Martino, Marilyn Michaels, Jim Nabors, Bobby Rydell, Ben Vereen and many others, and has shared the stage with Jazz greats including Gary Burton, Alan Dawson, Joe Lovano, Bob Moses, Herb Pomeroy, Leni Stern, Phil Wilson, and Warren Vache. John has been a featured performer on over 20 recordings in a variety of musical styles. Recent recordings include performances with "The Boston Big Band", "The World Leaders", "The Black Sea Salsa Band", and a host of vocalists from the New England area. Under his own leadership, John has released The "Be-Bop" Guitars & More!" (2000) and "Freshly Painted Blues" (2007), featuring his all-faculty guitar ensemble from Berklee called The "Be-Bop" Guitars. He recently returned from South Africa where his band played at the Cape Town Jazz Festival. His picture is included in the recently published book: "Faces Of Jazz" which features prominent New England Jazz artists. John is a voting member of The Recording Academy (Grammy's), an active member of the American Society of Composers, Authors & Publishers (ASCAP), a winner of many ASCAPPLUS writing awards, and a "Network With An Expert" consultant to the Jazz Education Network (JEN).

Dr. Michele Holt is a graduate of the University of Rhode Island where she received both a Bachelor of Music and a Masters of Arts in Music Education. She received a Doctor of Musical Arts in choral conducting at the Hartt School of Music where she completed research in Laban Movement Theory and its application to choral conducting and performance. Michele has studied conducting with James Jordan, Rodney Eichenberger, Elaine Brown, Howard Swan, Gerald Mack, Peter Bagley and Allen Lannom.

Michele has conducted All State and Regional Festivals in Connecticut, New York, Vermont, New Hampshire, Maine, Massachusetts, Rhode Island and Florida and has been clinician to numerous choral adjudication festivals, including the Manhattan Choral Festival, East Tennessee Vocal Association and Florida Vocal Arts Association. She has been an active adjudicator for All State auditions throughout the New England area and has been a clinician at both state and divisional conferences. Michele has presented sessions at several state and regional conferences including NAFME National Convention held in Minneapolis, MN, the Massachusetts, Rhode Island and Connecticut Music Educators State Conferences, and the NAFME Eastern Division Bi-Annual Conference held in Providence, Rhode Island. Michele is a very active member of the American Choral Directors Association. She is Past President of both Rhode Island ACDA and ACDA Eastern Division and was the National President for the American Choral Directors Association from 2003-2005.

Currently, Dr. Holt is Coordinator of Music Education at the University of Rhode Island where she also teaches Choral Conducting. Dr. Holt's recent publication, *The School Choral Program* published by GIA has been a successful contribution to the field of secondary music education. Dr. Holt has also been a contributing author to the third edition of *Teaching Music Through Performance in Choir* published by GIA in 2011.
