Mark A Stickney is Director of Bands at Plymouth State University, where he directs the Symphonic Band and Jazz Ensemble, and teaches courses in conducting, applied low brass and music education. In addition he serves as coordinator of the All New England Band Festival, All New England Jazz Festival and the New England Band Directors Institute. In 2013, Dr. Stickney was appointed coordinator for the graduate instrumental music education program at Plymouth State University.

Prior to his appointment at Plymouth State University, Dr. Stickney served for five years as Director of Bands at Southern Utah University in Cedar City, UT. He has also held conducting and brass teaching positions at the Community College of Rhode Island, Oklahoma Panhandle State University and Salve Regina University. He has conducted performances at the Utah Music Educators Association Conference and at Carnegie Hall. An active clinician and guest conductor, Dr. Stickney has worked with middle and high school bands throughout the United States and regularly conducts honors festivals throughout New England and the southwest.

Performing on trombone, euphonium and tuba, Dr. Stickney has been a member of The American Band, Fanfare Brass, The Narragansett Tuba Quartet. As a soloist and chamber musician, he has performed at the Newport Music Festival and throughout southern New England.

Orchestra

Educator, conductor, and cellist **Mark Churchill** is Dean Emeritus of New England Conservatory's Department of Preparatory and Continuing Education, which he led for 31 years. During his leadership of the Preparatory School, the program became known as one of the best of its kind in the nation, emphasizing serious, professional training for the pre-college student in addition to numerous community-based programs and local, national, and international partnerships.

Churchill is widely known as a conductor in New England and abroad. He has been Associate Conductor of the Boston Ballet since 1992, and is the founder and Music Director of Symphony Pro Musica, Worcester's Salisbury Lyric Opera, and the Salisbury Chamber Orchestra. He has also led the New Zealand National Youth Orchestra in its annual gala concert. He is the founder and vice president of the Youth Orchestra of the Americas, established in 2002, which draws gifted young musicians from throughout North and South America. He has been an active advocate for the improvement and expansion of music education programs in American

schools. He currently serves as director of El Sistema USA, the advocacy and service organization for American programs that emulate the renowned Venezuelan model of social development through music. In 2005, Churchill spearheaded the signing of the "Friendship Agreement" between New England Conservatory and Venezuela's massive El Sistema youth orchestral training program—planting the seeds for NEC's close relationship to that program.

Churchill serves on the boards of a number of non-profit organizations, including some closely affiliated with NEC: **Project STEP**, a pre-professional support program for string students of color; the **Conservatory Lab Charter School**, a K-5 public inner-city elementary school offering a music based curriculum; the **Walnut Hill School**, an independent school for serious high school age art students; and the **Youth Orchestra of the Americas**. Churchill also serves on the board of the Berkshire Institute for Theology and the Arts.

Jazz Ensemble

Jeffrey W. Holmes, Professor of Music and Director of Jazz and African-American Music Studies at the University of Massachusetts is a nationally commissioned composer/arranger, and a multiple recipient of National Endowment For The Arts Jazz Composition Grants. He has written music for John Abercrombie, Ernie Watts, Max Roach, Chris Vadala, Doc Severinsen, Paul Winter, Yusef Lateef, Rufus Reid, the Tommy Dorsey Orchestra, and the Big Apple Circus, as well as numerous works for college, high school and junior high jazz, concert, and marching ensembles.

He has toured /performed around the world and was a featured artist on the Jazz at the Kennedy Center series in Washington D.C with the Bill Taylor Trio. Other activities include ongoing appearances with the Paul Winter Consort, collegiate residencies, leading the Jeff Holmes Big Band and playing lead trumpet with the New England Jazz Ensemble, Rob Zappulla Big Band and Earl Macdonald’s New Horizons Ensemble, as well as drums with the Amherst Jazz Orchestra. Mr. Holmes received the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Massachusetts Association

of Jazz Educators, and is also the featured trumpet performer on the soundtrack to the PBS American Experience presentation “A Class Apart”, as well as contributing composer to the source music for the PBS series “Circus”.

At UMASS, Holmes directs the award-winning Jazz Ensemble I and Studio Orchestra. Students in the program have won over 40 DOWNBEAT Magazine Awards in virtually every annual collegiate Jazz category, and continue to appear at major national conferences. Recent recordings include CDs with the New York Latin All-Stars, the New England Jazz Ensemble (lead trumpet/arranger), the Paul Winter Consort, (piano/composer), and his own critically acclaimed quartet project “Of One’s Own” on Miles High Records. He also is a contributing composer to classical trumpeter Eric Berlin’s “Fantastique” (MSR Classics) with the UMASS Wind Ensemble, a 2015 Grammy nominee. He is also the Artistic Director of Jazz In July Summer Workshops at UMASS, and has served as a member of the Massachusetts Music Educators Association board of directors, columnist for JAZZPLAYER Magazine, and panelist for the National Endowment for the Arts, while contributing thirty jazz biographical entries to the New Groves Dictionary of American Music (Oxford Press).

Chorus

In recent years, conductor **Chris Shepard** has been closely associated with the choral music of Johann Sebastian Bach. He founded the Sydneian Bach Choir and Orchestra in Sydney, Australia, and was music director of *BACH 2010*, a project to perform all of Bach's choral cantatas. Under his direction, the ensemble performed over seventy-five cantatas, as well as the two *Passions*, *B Minor Mass*, and *Christmas Oratorio*.

In addition to the music of J.S. Bach, Chris has conducted many staples of the choral-orchestral repertoire, and he has commissioned and premiered a number of new choral works in both Australia and America. Chris serves as Music Director of two of America's most venerable choral ensembles: the Dessoff Choirs in New York City; and the Worcester Chorus in Worcester, Massachusetts. With the Dessoff Choirs, Chris has prepared the choir for performances at Carnegie Hall, Lincoln Center and Radio City Music Hall, including a performance of Ravel's *Daphnis and Chloe* with the Juilliard Orchestra under the direction of Yannick Nézet-Séguin and a performance of Bach's *B Minor Mass* with the Orquestra Sinfónica Nacional de Mexico for Carlos Miguel Prieto. He currently serves as Music Director of St John's Episcopal Church in Stamford, CT. Chris has conducted avocational choirs for more than two decades, including the Stamford MasterSingers, Greater Middletown Chorale and Waterbury Chorale in Connecticut. He began a new role as conductor of the Great Waters Festival Chorus in August 2012.

A committed music educator, Chris is served as guest Choral Director at the College of the Holy Cross for the 2011-13 school years. Teaching has long been a focus of his career; from 1996 to 2008, he served as Director of Music at Sydney Grammar School, one of Australia's most prominent high schools, and before moving to Sydney, Chris led the choral program at the Taft School in Watertown, Connecticut, where his Collegium Musicum appeared at the 1994 ACDA Eastern Division convention. Since 2004, Chris has been Music Director of the Hotchkiss Summer *Portals* Chamber Music Program, an intensive chamber music program for advanced young players and singers from around the world. He conducts the chamber orchestra and choir, serving on the faculty alongside such guest ensembles as the Shanghai Quartet, the Brentano String Quartet and *Cantus*.

Chris holds degrees from the Hartt School and the Yale School of Music, where he studied choral conducting with Marguerite Brooks. He earned his PhD in Musicology at the University of Sydney. His dissertation examining the performance history of Bach's *B Minor Mass* in 20th century America won the American Choral Directors Association's Julius Herford Prize.
